

AU offers summer workshops for young people interested in theater

This summer, Alfred University is conducting two sessions of Theater Workshops for Young People those who have completed grades three-nine. The sessions run daily from 1-4 p.m., Monday, June 30 through Thursday, July 3, and again Monday, July 7 through Friday, July 11. Participants can attend Workshop I only or Workshops I and II. Workshops will take place in the Miller Performing Arts Center on the Alfred University Campus. The cost is \$100 per week. Dr. Becky Prophet, Alfred University professor of theater is the director of this program. During the workshops students will be divided into two groups. The younger group (grades three-six) will focus on theater games, improvisation, and preparation for a performance on the last day of the program. The older group (grades seven-nine) will focus on acting, development of costumes, props, and preparation for a production which will be presented on the last day. All final performances from the workshops are open to the public. The registration form and payment to the Division of Performing Arts can be returned anytime before the day of the chosen workshop.
