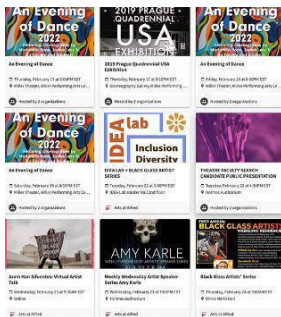
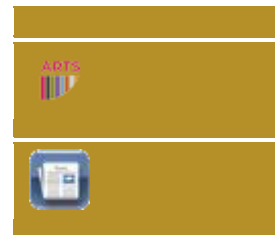

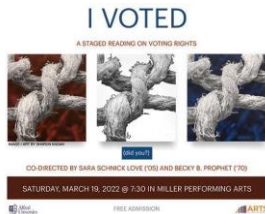

**Alfred University faculty, students, alumni participants at 2022 NCECA Conference**

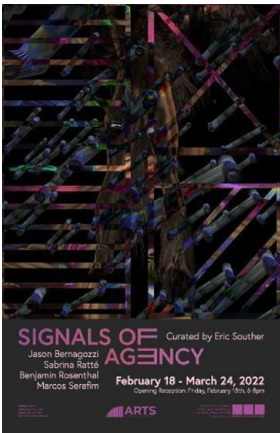
Alfred University is well represented at this week's 2022 National Council on Education for the Ceramic Arts (NCECA) Conference,

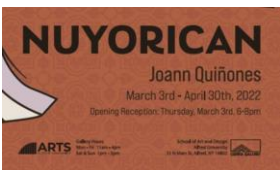
### **"Signals of Agency" Exhibition at the Fosdick-Nelson Gallery**

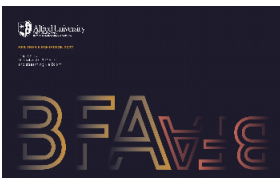
**Alfred University Art Force 5 project featured in two New York City television broadcasts**
