

## Women's basketball falls to Utica 74-66

The Alfred University women's basketball team fell to Utica College 74-66 Saturday afternoon. The Lady Saxons (4-8, 0-2 Empire 8) were down by 14 points at halftime and were able to bring it to a four point deficit with about a minute remaining in the game before Utica took the win. Leading the Saxons in points was senior forward Kylene Knoll (Elmira, NY/ Elmira Free Academy) who netted 18 points. Senior forward Meg Coddington (Amherst, NH. Souhegan) finished the game with a double-double scoring 14 points and grabbed a game high 12 rebounds. Freshman guard Colleen Montgomery (Chili, NY/ Churchville-Chili) chipped in 12 points to go along with two steals. Utica College shot 47 percent from behind the arc. Leading the team was Corrina Rustman with 18 points and five rebounds. Ava Thomas had a double-double scoring 16 points to go along with 10 rebounds. Whitney Frament and Karen Crisanti scored three, three pointers each as Frament finished the game with 15 points and Crisanti finished with nine points.
