ALFRED, NY – A Rochester-based guitar trio featuring Ken Luk, adjunct guitar instructor in Alfred University’s Division of Performing Arts, will perform on the Alfred University campus on Sunday, Oct. 27.

Trio Ghidorah will perform beginning at 3 p.m. on Sunday, Oct. 27, in Susan Howell Hall. The recital is free and open to the public.

The trio is made up of Luk, Bernardo Marcondes, and Eric Gibelyou and was formed while the three were pursuing their doctoral studies at Eastman School of Music. Since their debut last November, the group has been engaged in the Greater Rochester area, performing a diverse repertoire of compositions and arrangements from the classical canon, contemporary works, and Latin American music.

Next spring, Luk will be the instructor for a new introductory mandolin ensemble. The one-credit hour class will teach students basic note reading and playing skills, as well as history surrounding the mandolin.
