CLONE IDENTIFICATION OF THE AMERICAN BEECH TREE USING MOLECULAR GENETICS TECHNIQUES

The beetle scale attacks the bark of the American Beech tree and creates an opening for a fungus which causes Beech Bark Disease. This disease is fatal to all beech trees except those that are genetically resistant. Marie has used a variety of molecular techniques to identify genetic similarities and differences between beech trees in an attempt to identify and increase the number of trees resistant to this disease.
